- 7. The abstracts for Oral/Poster presentation must be sent as a soft copy (Word/PDF) to the Email ID: abstract.tropacon2024@gmail.com
- 8. Confirmation regarding acceptance for Oral/Poster presentation will be communicated via Email.
- 9. Posters must be printed on 3' X 4' size paper only in Portrait layout. Any other size posters will not be allowed.
- 10. Oral presentation must be prepared on a MS PowerPoint presentation format containing not more than 15 slides.




#### **BRAHMAPUTRA RIVER CRUISE**
